FORMER CAMPUS HOMES

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The following is a registry of the Texas A&M Campus Houses as developed by College Station's Historic Preservation Committee in June 2012. The list is based on two previous catalogs: Paul Van Riper's 1985 List and Van Riper's 1938 Campus Map Summary. The Campus House numbering system changed in May 1919 (previous numbers are included in parentheses next to the current official number).
