AGE DIVISIONS

- 10U Boys/Girls (8-10 years) | Age as of Jan. 1, 2021
- 12U Boys/Girls (10-12 years) | Age as of Jan. 1, 2021

SEASON

- Practice begins begin the week of **Jan. 11**
- Games will begin the week of **Feb. 1**

LOCATION

- All practices and games will be held at Lincoln Recreation Center, 1000 Eleanor Street, College Station, TX 77840

PRACTICE/GAME TIMES

- Tue., Thu. & Sat.
- Time slots are: 6:30, 7:30, and 8:30 p.m. and 9 a.m.-4 p.m. on Sat. (subject to change depending on number of teams)

UNIFORM/EQUIPMENT

- Teams will be provided reversible numbered pennies that they will be responsible for throughout the season. Any lost or damaged jersey will be replaced by athletics staff.
- Each team will be provided with four basketballs at the beginning of the season. It is your responsibility to sanitize the basketballs before and after use. Lost or deflated basketballs will be replaced with a limit of two more basketballs per team.

SPECIAL REQUEST

- All teams will be created and picked by athletics staff. There will be no drafting of teams by coaches.
- Players will be allowed one carpool request. Each player must request each other and must be in the same division.

COACHING

- For those interested in volunteering to coach in our league MUST fill out a volunteer coach form at cstx.gov/sportsvolunteer.
- All volunteers will be background checked and notified via email about filling out the form.
- Teams will be created by athletics staff based on the number of volunteer coaches.
- Parents may be asked to coach if there is a shortage of volunteer coaches.

- Once season schedules have been made live online athletics staff will notify all coaches and parents via email. Any changes to the schedule for any reason will be communicated to coaches via email.



COVID-19 RESPONSE

- Regarding all City of College Station sanctioned adult and youth athletics, in the event staff is notified of a confirmed, positive COVID case, we will notify team members by the email provided at registration of a possible exposure. That team will be asked to sit out for 14 days from the last date of play (game or practice). Staff will make every effort, within reason, to reschedule impacted games for that team. Additionally, each team member of any opposing teams with a resulting potential exposure will be notified and given the option to reschedule, but not required.
