

## BRUSH & BULK COLLECTION NOTICE

Brush and bulk items must be set out by 8 a.m. on your collection day.

- · Separate brush & bulk piles
- Cut brush down to lengths of 8 feet or less
- Place stacks within 3 feet of the curb line
- · Hazardous waste will not be collected
- Appliances with freon units will not be collected
- Do not place piles under low-hanging tree limbs, on top of water meters, in front of parked cars or other obstructions
- · If possible, do not place piles on sidewalks
- Do not place piles in vacant lots
- 20 bags maximum per collection day

## NO SERVICE PERFORMED TODAY

- 1 Placed under low-hanging limbs or lines
- 2 On or too close to stationary objects
- 3 Placed too close to/or parked cars are blocking collection
- 4 Household waste extra container needed
- 5 Contamination or hazardous materials we found:
