

# *Disposing of Pool Chemicals*

NEVER place pool chemicals out for curbside collection in your solid waste bin or out for bulk collection; this poses a significant safety risk to our Solid Waste Operators, Emergency Services, and causes truck fires.

### **PROPER DISPOSAL:**

- Do not mix different pool chemicals
- Always keep chemicals in their original containers
- Follow clean-up instructions outlined on chemical labels or Safety Data Sheets (SDSs)
- If chemicals are spilled, use proper materials and equipment for clean-up; i.e. absorbent pads, granules, or other chemical-specific materials
- Participate in free, semi-annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Events every April & October

When pool chemicals are disposed of safely and appropriately, property damage, environmental harm, and injuries are prevented. When in doubt, call your pool maintenance professional or the City of College Station with your disposal questions!
