It covers the seven counties of the Brazos Valley. The BTD is a political subdivision of Texas and receives funding through the Federal Transportation Administration (FTA) and the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT).

MEDICAID RECIPIENTS:

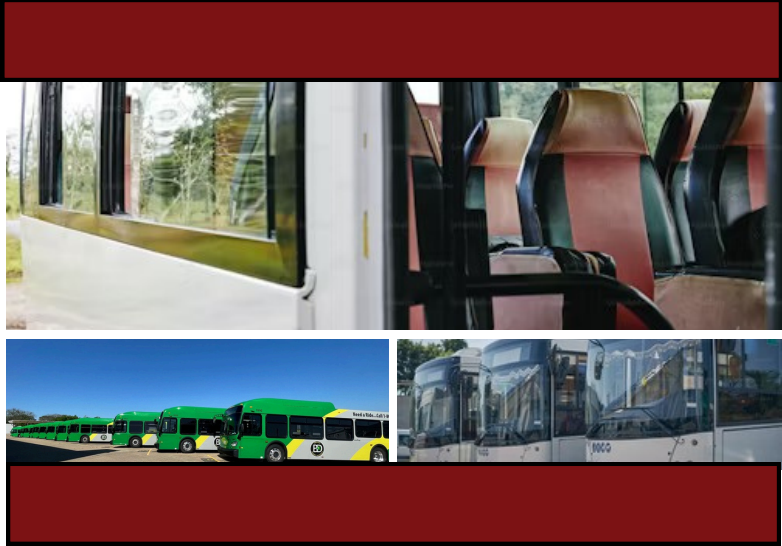
